USS KING DLG-10/DDG-41 2003 REUNION JULY 24-27 NORFOLK AIRPORT HILTON NORFOLK, VA

The Norfolk Airport Hilton will host the USS KING reunion. The Hilton is located at 1500 North Military Highway, Norfolk, VA. The Hilton is probably the best reunion hotel in the country.

Two miles from Norfolk International Airport, the Hilton Norfolk Airport offers a comfortable environment for guests with easy access to Interstate 64. Their standard rooms far exceed most guests' expectations! Each spacious room is luxuriously appointed with the finest in furnishings, including a refreshment center, coffee maker, cable TV with premium channels and pay-per-view movies, radio alarm clocks, desks, computer data ports, iron/ironing board, and all the other amenities usually associated with premium service. Those amenities include a Multi-Lingual Staff, Laundry/Valet Service, Baggage Storage, Barber Shop/Beauty Salon, Clothing Store, Concierge Desk, Gift Shop, News Stand, Safety Deposit Box, Shoe Shine Stand, Room Service and an exercise facility.

Three restaurants (one of them being an expensive "fine dining" place) and a super cocktail lounge are in the hotel.

Complimentary shuttle service is provided to and from the Norfolk International Airport every thirty minutes, on the hour and half-hour.

Normal check in time is 3:00 PM but every effort will be made to have rooms available before then. In case they are not, just relax in the hospitality room until your room is ready.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

First, a sincere thank you for allowing us to continue being a part of your reunion. We pledge our best efforts to insure your reunion will be a memorable event.

Based on comments contained in the evaluations from last year, the Chairman's input, some procedural changes have been made. Please read the administrative guidelines carefully. If you have any questions, do not hesitate to call our Customer Service Representative at 1-828-256-6008 for assistance.

You may select either of the three options, or you may create your own limited agenda. Please complete and return the registration form before June 23, 2003. You may fax, mail or phone in your registration. Reservations via fax or phone require use of a credit card. **MASTERCARD** and **VISA** are the only credit cards accepted.

1. **Option A requires a \$100.00 per person deposit** which must accompany your reservation.
2. **Option B requires a \$75.00 per person deposit** which must accompany your reservation.
3. **Option C requires a \$50.00 per person deposit** which must accompany your reservation.
4. Persons selecting either Option A or Option B and paying both the initial deposit and final on site payment by the preferred method - personal check, travelers check, money order, or cash will be given a **three percent (3%)** discount from the total reunion price. The discount will be automatically applied so you don't have to do anything. If your initial deposit is made by personal check, money order or travelers check, your confirmation letter will show both the discounted and non-discounted balances due.
5. **The "create your own option" requires full payment** which must accompany your reservation. This option is not discounted.
6. Persons who register for the reunion, but do not attend without canceling through Military Locator & Reunion Service, Inc will be charged the full amount of their option. Cancellation through the hotel is not sufficient.

7. **Likewise, All Reservations** must be made through ML & RS, Inc, and should be received on or before June 23, 2003 Reservations received June 24, 2003 or later will be accommodated on a space available basis - with the **probability** of not receiving reunion rates. "Walk-Ins" will be accommodated—space available—at **regular** hotel rates.
8. **Cancellations and Refunds:** All Cancellations must be made through ML & RS, Inc. Cancellations received **31 or more days** before the reunion start date will receive a full refund of their deposit, minus a \$25.00 cancellation fee. Cancellations received between **5 and 30 days** before the reunion will be refunded 50% of their deposit minus the cost of any events already paid for by ML & RS, Inc, and the cost of any events for which guaranteed numbers have been provided. There will be **NO REFUNDS - FOR ANYTHING - FOR ANY REASON** for cancellations received less than five days prior to the reunion start date. Last minute medical emergencies, family situations, inclement weather events, etc do happen, so for this reason full payment will not be accepted with your reservation. Send only the required deposit.
9. As soon as you arrive at the Hilton, stop by the Military Locator & Reunion Service, Inc desk to complete your reunion registration and pick up your packet. You will then need to stop by the hotel front desk to register with the hotel and pick up your room key.
10. Every effort will be made to accommodate your special needs requests; however we must know about them. If you require special equipment (wheelchair, walker, portable oxygen, etc) you must bring it with you to the reunion or arrange for its rental and delivery. Please be specific on your needs. For example, do you need a fully handicapped room with wide doors, roll-in shower, grab bars; a room with just grab bars, do you have walking problems and just need a room near the elevator. List your special requirements on the registration form, then discuss them with the ML & RS, Inc reunion manager when you check in at the reunion.
11. As you know, each person attending the reunion pays a small daily registration fee. To insure

that everyone is treated fairly, please understand that if you arrive at the reunion before the day/time specified in your option, it will be necessary for you to pay a daily registration fee for each day you are early. For example, if you register for "*banquet only*" and arrive on Thursday or Friday "*just to see who is here*" you'll be expected to pay the same registration fee as your shipmates who pre-registered for those days.

12. Every effort will be made to house members of the group together; however, due to the many different types of room requests, smoking, non-smoking; king, double, etc it is not always possible to keep everyone together and honor specific room-type requests.
13. Importance of timely registration: Banquet and Hospitality space for our reunion will be allocated based on the number of guests registered on the cut-off date of June 23rd. If there are people who register after the cut off date, they will of course be accommodated when possible, but you should be aware that if the numbers increase substantially, it is possible the banquet and hospitality space will become extremely crowded. When an increase in numbers occurs after the cut-off date, the hotel will move us into a larger room ONLY IF ALL HOSPITALITY AND BANQUET SPACE HAS NOT BEEN SOLD. If there is no other space available, then of course we must live with the space allocated on the cut-off date. Timely registration can help prevent overcrowding.

PLEASE NOTE

The entire reunion agenda was created from responses to the survey sent to everyone on the mailing list as of December 1, 2002, and the input from the Reunion Chairman. We appreciate the interest and help of those responding. The activities and events that are on the itinerary, are the most requested. There were a few surprises. The two most notable were, not just a clear majority, but an overwhelming majority did not want any form of entertainment after the banquet and very few people wanted to go to Williamsburg, normally a huge attraction.

Thursday July 24, 2003

1200 Noon: Reunion registration begins and hospitality room opens. Relax in the comfort and privacy of your hospitality room where you will find coffee, soft drinks and snacks. This is where the reunion starts. It's the perfect place to greet old friends, especially those that you haven't seen in years, to meet shipmates you didn't know, to meet shipmates who served at a different time but share your ship's heritage. Please be aware that because of liquor liability considerations, private alcoholic beverages may not be brought into the hospitality room. The hospitality room will close during the reception.

5:00 PM: Welcome reception begins. A cash bar will be available for your pleasure. There will hors' d'oeuvres served. After the Chairman's welcome remarks, first time attendees will be asked to introduce themselves so everyone will be acquainted. This will be a fun evening in a relaxed and casual atmosphere. Dress is casual. Dinner is on your own tonight. *Cost of the reception is included in the price of Option A only.*

Friday July 25, 2003

7:30 - 8:30 AM: Breakfast will be a private buffet. *Cost of breakfast is included in the price of Option A only.*

9:00 AM: Tour departs. The short ride to the downtown Norfolk waterfront for a visit to Nauticus, The national Maritime Center. Features here include a series of ingenious interactive exhibits, shows and theaters. Enjoy the Academy Award nominated film "The Living Seas" which celebrates the beauty, power and significance of the ocean. Also housed here is the Hampton Roads Naval Museum. A true highlight of your visit will be a visit to the battleship *USS WISCONSIN*, which saw action in WW II, Korea, and most recently in the Persian Gulf War. The main deck and sections of the two upper decks are open for you to explore. Next, you'll board the *Spirit of Norfolk*, for a two hour luncheon cruise. Feast on

a sumptuous buffet and enjoy the narrated tour of the harbor. Following the cruise you can visit *Waterside*, Norfolk's exciting waterfront festival market place located on the Elizabeth River. Finally, learn about Norfolk's colorful 320 year history as you ride through the historic district and many other points of interest. At this printing, we can still get on the navy base for a riding tour. If that opportunity is still available we will take advantage of it, going directly there from the cruise instead of Waterside and a riding tour of Norfolk. Either way, you'll return to the hotel around 4:00 PM. There is a minimum of thirty-five persons for the tour to go. *If you do not wish to participate in this tour, you may "opt-out." See the reservation form for details. Please note: In order to enter the Naval Base, an advance list must be provided to Naval Security. Anyone going on the tour must provide their social security number (see tour registration form) and upon arrival at the base, have in your possession a photo ID (driver's license, military ID Card, etc). Camera's are allowed but the Navy guide will tell you where photos are authorized. Taking pictures in unauthorized areas will result in having your camera confiscated and the film removed. Back-packs, large shopping bags, etc are not allowed. Because of the advance list requirement and social security number, there can be no last minute "sign-ups" for this tour.*

9:30 AM: If there are Friday arrivals and/or some people do not go on the tour, the **Hospitality Room** will open - with coffee and soft drinks only - until mid afternoon when snacks will be served. Otherwise the hospitality room will not open until the tour returns.

6:00 PM: Social Hour. Enjoy your favorite beverage from the cash bar while you relax with friends.

7:00 PM: Dinner will be a traditional Virginia Ham Dinner. No after dinner entertainment is planned to allow for plenty of socializing time! *Cost of tonight's dinner is included in both Options A and B.
